Kootenai Valley Partners Habitat for Humanity is now accepting applications for next summer's (2022) work projects. Since the affiliate only builds in odd numbered years, they set aside the even numbered years to help with a home repair program. ***Deadline for application is December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.***

The types of repairs provided are:

- Minor exterior repairs, including steps, decks or wheelchair ramps
- Painting
- Weather stripping
- Brush removal

If you own your own home (don't rent), are on a restricted income and have home repair work that you cannot physically or financially complete, you may qualify. Habitat will use volunteer labor and only charge you for the materials (unless a contractor is needed). The homeowner is eligible for a no-interest loan.
